- GSC Awards are divided into 3; Travel award, Conference award, and Project award
- Project Award
 - Deadline 1st Friday in November for Fall semester and 1st Friday in March for the spring semester.
 - Submit application via GSC email <u>GSC-OFFICERS@listserv.uic.edu</u>
 - Awards are voted on at the regular meeting after the presentation of the project
- Travel Awards
 - \circ No out of state travel award for this Fall semester due to safety concerns



- Divided into four quarters:
 - Quarter 1: May 01st July 31st
 - Quarter 2: August 01st October 31st
 - Quarter 3: November 01st January 31st
 - Quarter 4: February 01st April 30th
- Applications should be submitted within the quarter of the intended travel
- For presenters submit proof of acceptance e.g an email from the organizers
- The amount is \$300 for in-state travel
- Conference Awards
 - Introduced last academic year (2020-2021) due to the pandemic
 - Funds virtual conferences from registration to presentation and in-person attendance within Chicago.
 - The amount was increased from \$75 last year to \$200 for this academic year
 - All awards are given on a first come first serve basis
 - Funds for the academic year ends on May 15, 2022
